Special Presentation: Jen Laughy (Complex Programming)

- A. Tour of Blue Pod Complex Learning composed of CSSI/TASC/ACCESS/ALP
 - (i) Currently the program supports 41 students with CSSI moving to Mountain Park in the fall. All 3 grades share the same learning spaces.
 - (ii) Focusing on life skills, community literacy, vocational programing and functional academics, self-regulation strategies. Programs vary in content based on current student body needs.
 - (iii) Each class has access to movement, sensory, and calming spaces. Gym with a dedicated instructor, electives and field trips when possible. Hopes to convert the closing CSSI program room with a dedicated sensory and movement area with special equipment (~\$20K to furnish)
